TRANSITION UPDATE

Red Lily Health and NT Health continue with discussions around the next transitions of services. These include:

Management of outreach clinical services

We are planning to transition some of the Outreach services in the latter half of 2023

and early next year.

Medical services for Warruwi, Jabiru and Gunbalanya

Red Lily have an arrangement with NT Health for a Doctor at Minjilang and have

continued discussions with NT Health regarding Doctors for Warruwi, Jabiru and Gunbalanya.

There have been many difficulties in recruitment of doctors all around

Australia but particularly with remote service provision.

Jabiru Health Centre

The new Health Centre should be completed towards the end of 2023 and transition will

take place by April 2024, following a period of 'bedding in' of the building.

Gunbalanya Health Centre

The new building development has been enhanced by an NTG announcement that \$20

million will be allocated for the building. We are expecting that the allocation will be formalised in the upcoming NTG budget in May 2023. This will then allow Red Lily to plan for a date to transition the services based from Gunbalanya. This has been a long-awaited allocation of funds and will be welcomed by all residents of the area and all stakeholders.
