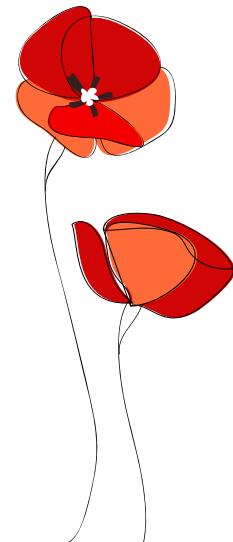

BIBI PLANES ARE PILOTLESS AIRCRAFT AND ARE ALREADY IMPROVING THE DELIVERY OF MEDICINES AND OTHER HEALTH CARE PRODUCTS TO REMOTE COMMUNITIES ACROSS AFRICA AND ASIA. WEST ARNHAM WILL BE THE FIRST TRIAL OF BIBI PLANES IN AUSTRALIA.

BEFORE WE START TRANSPORTING MEDICINES, WE FIRST NEED TO TRIAL THE BIBI PLANES AND SEE IF THEY WILL COPE WITH THE TOP-END WEATHER. RED LILY HEALTH BOARD WILL DECIDE WHERE THE BIBI PLANES WILL FLY TO FIRST.
