Transition update

Management of outreach clinical services

We are planning to transition some of the Outreach services in the latter half of 2023 and early next year.

Medical services for Waruwi, Jabiru and Gunbalanya

Red Lily have an arrangement with NT Health for a Doctor at Minjilang and have continued discussions with NT Health regarding Doctors for Waruwi, Jabiru and Gunbalanya.

There have been many difficulties in recruitment of doctors all around Australia but particularly with remote service provision.

Jabiru Health Centre

NT Government have advised that the new Health Centre should be completed early 2024 and transition will take place by April 2024, following a period of 'bedding in' of the building.

Gunbalanya Health Centre

The new building development has been enhanced by an NTG announcement that \$20 million will be allocated for the building. Allocation of the funding has been announced in the recent NTG budget.

This will then allow Red Lily to plan for a date to transition the services based from Gunbalanya. This is a long-awaited allocation of funds and is welcomed by all residents of the area and all stakeholders.
